MinneMinds is supported by a broad base of statewide organizations and thought leaders with a common commitment to prioritizing Minnesota's youngest children as the most pressing need and important investment for Minnesota. HOW THE COALITION WORKS

MinneMinds adheres to a multi-year strategy and participates in allied efforts as opportunities arise. The Coalition conducts activities in support of the policy agenda, and is organized around legislative priorities. The Coalition's Executive Committee provides direction to develop goals, objectives, and action plans; and engage in active and ongoing communication with Coalition members to fulfill MinneMinds' objectives.

Members of the Advisory Committee, a subcommittee of the Coalition, provide broad stakeholder input and share data, best practices and other information to help guide MinneMinds strategy.

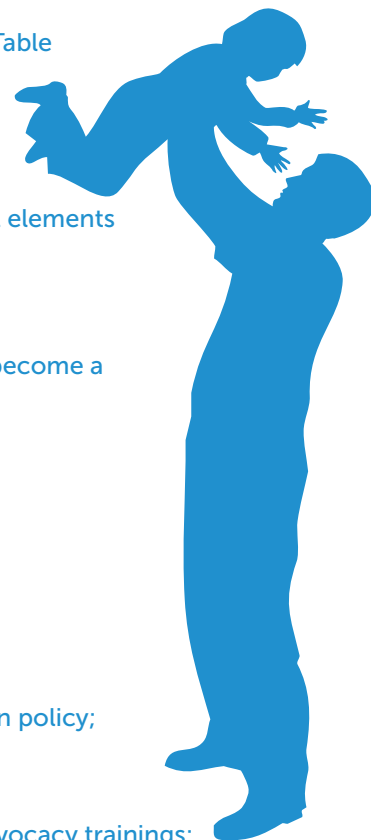

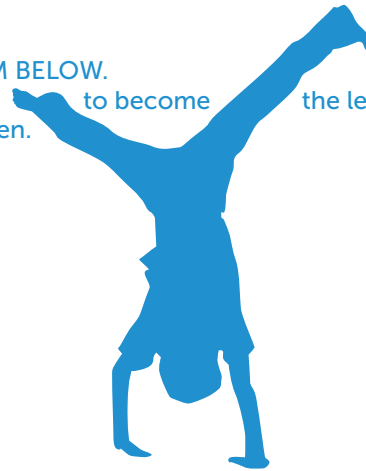
THE BENEFITS OF JOINING MINNEMINDS
